› The most expensive set of panniers on test, but also the most well-specified. And the largest: despite a claimed capacity of 60 litres - less than several others here - the P60R is the only set that swallowed everything in our packing test.

Despite their size, they're straightforward to fit. There's a dedicated underseat strap in addition to the two Velcro seat straps. Each pannier has three built-in, adjustable webbing straps to help mount it to the bike without bungee cords, and

each of these has a neat Velcro tab to tidy away length of spare strap - impressive attention to detail. The P60R comes with internal drybags rather than rain covers, though the mediocre shower test result shows the importance of using them.
